MIRIAM – 27 Just finished her thesis. A good student. Always the respectful, obliging daughter. Never lives up to her own expectations. Not a party animal, but that may change today.

PIERRE - 27 Worships Evel Knievel. Thrives on taking risks. Life of the party. About to make a huge life change.

BLAIR – 26 Erotic, sexual, free, fun. Lives by her own rules. Charming, a brat. Independent and goes for what she wants.

ROMAN - 27 Bit of a cuck, but he likes it. Driven by money and status. Has no shame.

SYD – 27 Takes it easy. Doesn't want much out of life. The elusive outsider that always seems to be around. *Must know how to tap dance or be willing to learn.

JOEY – 32 Driven, smart, and a bit pompous because of it. Followed the expected life path. His parents are proud of him.

This piece is physically demanding and requires excellent stamina and a deep understanding of the body and its limits. Each role demands a high level of physical literacy, such as training or experience in modern dance improv, and/or Laban Technique, and/or Viewpoints. *Performers based locally will be prioritized due to pre-rehearsal period movement training*.
